Use these tips for a strong password:

1 Don't use passwords containing dictionary words



2 Don't use repeat characters in your passwords, like '444', '!!!', or 'abcd1234'



3 Don't use "relevant" words (e.g. the name of the service, name of the company, address, username, etc.)



4 Avoid password reuse



5 Incorporate non-standard password characters and misspellings (COff33&Te@ instead of CoffeeTea)



6 Combine unrelated words (RedPanda\$Glacier9!)



7 Use a password manager such as Bitwarden or Lastpass
